Added Mounting Holes for "Lay Flat"
Operation

We have recently added a new capability to our ABLK. We have added 3 additional holes for inserting the yarn guide posts. These allow you to lay the lid flat when you need to do so.

Just insert your posts into the 3 holes that are located toward the center of the lid as opposed to ones that run along the front edge. You can then lay the lid flat which will not add any tension to the yarn based on the effects of gravity.



If your ABLK does not have these holes, it is easy to add them. You just need a few items:
A portable drill, a ruler or measuring tape, a pencil or pen, some fine sand paper, and a 1/4" drill bit.

Locate hole in 1.75" from left edge and 1.75" from front edge

Locate this hole 6.75" from left and right edges, and 1.75" from front edge

Locate hole in 1.75" from right edge and 1.75" from front edge

Use a 1/4" drill bit to drill the hole. Drill from the top of the unit. Do not allow the drill bit to hit the bottom of the inside. Sand both sides of hole lightly. Use Minwax brand Golden Oak stain.
